- The Danish National Strategy for AI 2019
  - One particular initiative on language technology sprogteknologi.dk

• Finance

- Joint financial agreements (Central government, regional governments and local governments) – 2020
- 2,6 million euros 2019 2026
- Political support since then:
  - <u>Further ratified in the latest National Strategy for</u> <u>Digitalisation – May 2022</u>
  - Joint Government Digitalisation Strategy 2022 2025


# Aim of the initiative sprogteknologi.dk

- Focus = resources rather than model(s)



- Creation of language resources for Danish
- 162 language resources available on sprogteknologi.dk
- Annual conference for Danish language technology
- Workshops, topic meetings/discussions
- Inputs into related political strategies and initiatives
- Inputs to public projects with language technology
