

- 1774 organisations (research orgs., companies)


Users can connect to the ELG cloud platform via ELG APIs, remote APIs, ELG GUI, Python SDK, download of containers or source code.

Number of Resources over Time








Number of Users (Consumers of LT, Providers of LT)

ELE Programme




- Digital Language Equality recognised by the EP as an important goal
- ELE Programme specified in the ELE SRIA between 500 and 750 colleagues participated
- ELE book 150+ contributors
- Strong support for the overall initiative and goal
- Shared programme between the EU and the participating countries
- EU/EC concentrates on the EDIC currently
- Conceptual similarities between the ELE Programme and the EDIC construct
- Suggest to identify and make use of synergies between the ELE Programme and the Language Data Space as well as the Language EDIC

The Future of European Language Technology

- Several strong European Language Technology initiatives, among others:
 - European Language Grid $01/2019 \rightarrow 06/2022$
 - European Language Equality $1 01/2021 \rightarrow 06/2022$
 - European Language Equality $2 07/2022 \rightarrow 06/2023$
 - Language Data Space $-01/2023 \rightarrow 12/2025$ (plus 12 months, if extended)
 - Language EDIC approx. 2024 onwards → ∞
- Challenge 1: Danger to re-invent the wheel
- Challenge 2: European initiatives do not have a "natural champion" in the EDIC construct
- Let's make sure that our previous projects including national projects and especially European initiatives benefit from the Language EDIC and its long-term prospect


